### Jorge Adrián Rincón Plata

Jorge Adrián Rincón Plata has a Law degree from *Universidad Autónoma de Bucaramanga* and a LL.M from International Business Law in Queen Mary & Westfield College-University of London. He has additional studies in international law, foreign exchange regulation and securities' market regulation. He is currently Legal Vice-president in *Grupo Aval Acciones y Valores S.A.*, where he began working in 2012, and has more than 15 years of experience in the financial and banking sector. He is part of Aval Financial Conglomerate since 2006 as Lawyer in *Banco de Bogotá*'s Legal Division and as Legal Advisor to the International & Treasury Vice-presidency.

Mr. Rincón has participated in some of the Group's main transactions, including the acquisition of BAC Credomatic by *Banco de Bogotá*, the acquisition of *AFP Horizonte* by *AFP Porvenir*, of *Grupo Financiero Reformador* in Guatemala and of *Banco BBVA, Panamá* by BAC Credomatic and most recently, the acquisition of Multifinancial Group Inc., owner of Multibank, panamanian bank.

Furthermore, he has participated in several operations in local and international markets, including Banco de Bogotá's first international bond issuance, as well as the IPO of Grupo Aval in the NYSE.

#### **Tomás González Estrada**

Tomás González is currently Director of the Regional Center for Energy Studies (*Centro Regional de Estudios de Energía CREE*). He holds a Bachelor Degree in Economics from *Universidad de los Andes* and PhD in Economics from London University. His professional interests are focused on energy markets and on energy policy and regulation.

He has been Mines and Energy Minister, Economic Advisor to the Presidency, Foreign Affairs Manager for BP in Colombia and Venezuela and, more recently, Alternate Executive Director in the IMF. He has served in several boards of directors, including *Ecopetrol, ISA* e *Isagén*, the Regulation Commission on Energy and Gas and the National Council on Economic and Social Policy.

Additionally, he has worked in the field of public opinion, evaluating important government initiatives and supporting the development of strategies for political campaigns.

He has taught economics in Colombia and abroad and is currently teaching Energy Economics at *Universidad de Los Andes*.
